HORSE ENTRIES: Our parades are CSHA sanctioned & judged by a licensed General Rules and Information

1. **Entry Fees:** \$50.00 (Schools, Community Orgs, Veteran Groups) \$70.00 (Business)
2. **Entry Deadline:** June 20th. Late entries accepted only upon approval and require a **\$10 late fee** per entry.
3. **Check-In Time:** **8:00-9:00am** **Location:** 1111 Civic Center Drive (Chamber of Commerce)
4. **Assembly: Enter Parade Through: Webster & Civic Center OR Kentucky & Union ONLY** *See Map**
5. Parade is traditional, allowing 1 **minute** at Reviewing Stand; **Full performances will disqualify entries from judging.**
6. The American Legion Flag Code will apply to all Color/Honor Guards.
7. Entries may not participate in the parade route more than one (1) time.
8. No political entries. Local, current elected office holders are invited as guests, but are not eligible for awards.
9. All participating vehicles must, at all times, be controlled with all wheels of vehicle (s) on pavement at all times, including motorcycles, bicycles and ATV's.
10. Animals must, at all times, be leashed while participating in vehicle (s) or walking.
11. No one under 8 yrs. of age may appear as an entry unless accompanied by an adult over 18 years.
12. The reviewing stand will be located at the **right** side of the line up. Entry numbers should be prominently displayed on the right, front of the vehicle or first element in the entry.
13. **Units with unusual sounds or loud noises of any kind must indicate so on the Entry Form.**
14. Entries must maintain a distance of fifty (50) apart, keeping elements as close together as possible.
15. **NO THROWING OF OBJECTS/CANDY FROM ANY ENTRY: Subject to immediate removal from line-up.**
16. Bands and musical entries must play through the entire parade.
17. **Entries must present and maintain in keeping with a family-oriented event: Absolutely No depiction of violence or overt sexual content.**
