- 1. CHECK IN: TIME: 10:30am-12:00pm PLACE: Chamber of Commerce: 1111 Webster Street
- 2. Participants will abide by parade official rules and instructions; subject to immediate removal from line-up.
- 2. **ASSEMBLY AREAS:** Along Webster & Kentucky Street, beginning at Kentucky.
- 3. REVIEWING STAND & JUDGING:
 - Entry allowed **ONE MINUTE** for a salute or presentation at Reviewing Stand
 - Full Performances are not allowed and will be disqualified from judging
 - Presentations are not permitted throughout the parade
- 4. No political entries. Local, current elected office holders are invited as guests, but are not eligible for awards.
- 5. The American Legion Flag Code will apply to all Color/Honor Guards.
- 6. Entries may not participate in the parade route more than one (1) time.
- 7. Participants with vehicles entries must, at all times, maintain control of said vehicles. Wheel on ALL Vehicles must be kept on pavement at all times, including motorcycles, bicycles and ATV's.
- 8. Animals must, at all times, be leashed while participating in vehicle(s) or walking.
- 9. No one under 8 yrs. of age may appear as an entry unless accompanied by an adult over 18 years.
- 10. The reviewing stand will be located at the **right** side of the line up. Entry numbers should be prominently displayed on the right, front of the vehicle or first element in the entry.
- 11. Units with unusual sounds or loud noises of any kind must indicate so on the Entry Form.
- 12. Entries must maintain a distance of fifty (50) apart, keeping elements as close together as possible.
- 13. NO THROWING OF OBJECTS OR CANDY FROM ANY ENTRY: SUBJECT TO IMMEDIATE REMOVAL FROM THE LINE UP.
- 14. Bands and musical entries must play throughout the entire parade.
- 15. Entries are required to maintain in keeping with a family-oriented event: Absolutely No depiction of violence or overt sexual content.
