FAIRFIELD — The 26th annual Tomato Festival is returning Aug. 19-20 with two stages for entertainment, a classic car show, a carnival, vendors and, of course, lots of tomatoes.

The festival is held in downtown Fairfield.

There are several tomato cooking contests planned, all hosted by Il Fiorello Olive Oil Company.

The Fairfield-Suisun Chamber of Commerce will host a VIP Wine, Food & Brew experience from 3 to 6 p.m. on Aug. 19 inside the Solano County Events Center, 601 Texas St. It will include local wineries, breweries and food establishments. Tickets are \$45 in advance and \$50 at the door.

The carnival opens at 3 p.m. on the first day. Pre-event, all-day wristbands are available at the Fairfield Main Street Association's office for \$20. The price is \$25 during the festival. The office is at 1000 Webster St.
